By now, many people in Wicklow will have visited the truly excellent exhibition, *Seamus Heaney: Listen Now Again*, (College Green, Dublin) and many may have visited the *Seamus Heaney HomePlace* Centre, (Bellaghy, Derry), both offering extremely worthwhile and enjoyable visitor experience.

To pay tribute on Seamus Heaney's 80th Birthday - 13th April, 2019, Ashford Community & Heritage Centre will hold a six day exhibition, starting Saturday 13th April, from 11am to 5pm daily and concluding on Thursday 18th April, at 5pm. On display will be photographs, manuscripts, poems and essays - in addition to audio visual screening of Seamus (with Marie Heaney) reading in the Holy Rosary Church, Ashford, in July 2012 and the RTE documentary, "Out of the Marvellous". Admission is free.
